GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

TOWN OF GRAND COULEE

BYLAW NO. 04-2017

The Council of the Town of Grand Coulee, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be known and referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw".
- 2. "Municipality" means the Town of Grand Coulee.
- 3. Section 4 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
- 4. Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
- In the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$2,000 and, in the case of a a. continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$500 for each day during which the offence continues; and
- In the case of a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$5,000 and, in the case of a b. continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$1,500 for each day during which the offence continues.
