#1. White Butte Detachment Staffing Update:

-S/Sgt. Detachment Commander, Sgt. Operations NCO and Cpl. Supervisor NCO positions are all filled at this time.

-Cst. Sarah Gamache has arrived and her first day was July 17th. White Butte is very excited to have her as part of the White Butte Team.


- One Cst. position is vacant as the Team lost Cst. Peter Rhead in early July. Peter has been transferred to National Security in Regina. Staffing has been working to find a replacement.

#2. Calls for Service – Analysis last 56 days (June 15, 2023 to August 10, 2023)

#3. Calls of Interest:

1 – On June 20th, White Butte Detachment was conducting a curfew check at a residence on a person who was on conditions from court for a break and enter. The person was not obeying by their curfew conditions and as such 26 year old Mitchell Hubenig was charged with failure to comply with conditions under Section 145 of the Criminal Code. A warrant was put out for his arrest. A few weeks later on July 23rd White Butte members continued to investigate and arrested Michell on his breaches. Excellent work on this property crime file. File 2023-886676 refers.

2– On July 3rd, White Butte received a call of an airplane that was downed. Once members were able to locate the airplane it was determined to be south of Redhead Equipment in a

canola field. The pilot was headed to YQR when he became extremely low on fuel. Not wanting to take the chance the pilot set the plane down in a rural area south of the number 1 Highway. Once the plane was checked over for fitness of flight the pilot was able to get fuel and take off the next day with the RCMP assisting with traffic control. File 2023-951964 refers.

3- On July 5th, White Butte members dispatched to a file of an overdue car from a car rental company in Calgary. The car rental company was able to track the vehicle via GPS and it was near the Town of Balgonie at the Flying J. Members attended to investigate the potential overdue / stolen auto. While doing so other oddities and inconsistencies arose. 32 year old Alan Burak and 28 year old Noman Hamidy have since been charged with several offences under the tobacco act as well as possession of property obtained by crime. File 2023-965123 refers.

4- On July 7th, White Butte members were on patrol in the St.Joseph's area and pulled over 27 year old Bradley Madeley on his ATV in the Snake Trail area because he threw a beer can on the ground and the member decided to investigate further. Investigation revealed that there was open alcohol, impaired driving as well as he was a suspended driver. Perfect example of a proactive patrol yielding positive results! File 2023-977278 refers.

5- On July 8th, White Butte members received a call of an erratic driver on Highway # 48. Members went to patrol for the subject vehicle and located it. Driver admitted to drinking. The impaired investigation was started and 31 year old Jennifer Langmo was charged with impaired driving and drive while over 80 mg%. File 2023-984832 refers.

6- On July 28th, White Butte Detachment received a call from Regina Police Service that a female's ex-husband was suicidal and has possibly left the City of Regina. Investigation led the officers to a field to the south of Regina. Members were able to locate the vehicle of the male. It was known that the male had several firearms at his disposal. The male had just recently been let go from his job and was down on his luck. The male was going to commit suicide and the RCMP was able to talk him down and he arrested without any further incident. All of the male's firearms have been seized for safekeeping. File 2023-1099494 refers.

7- White Butte Detachment has been slowly working on a new offender management program. This program involves the assessment, grading and placing of certain prolific offenders that are considered at a high risk to offend or re-offend. This would assist the White Butte RCMP officers to keep track of and manage the highest priority offenders all in the efforts to reduce the risk of re-offending.

#4. RPCC Investigations. 3 assaults, 1 possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose, 1 mischief and 23 assistance files. The total for the reporting period is 28.
