#1. White Butte Detachment Staffing Update:

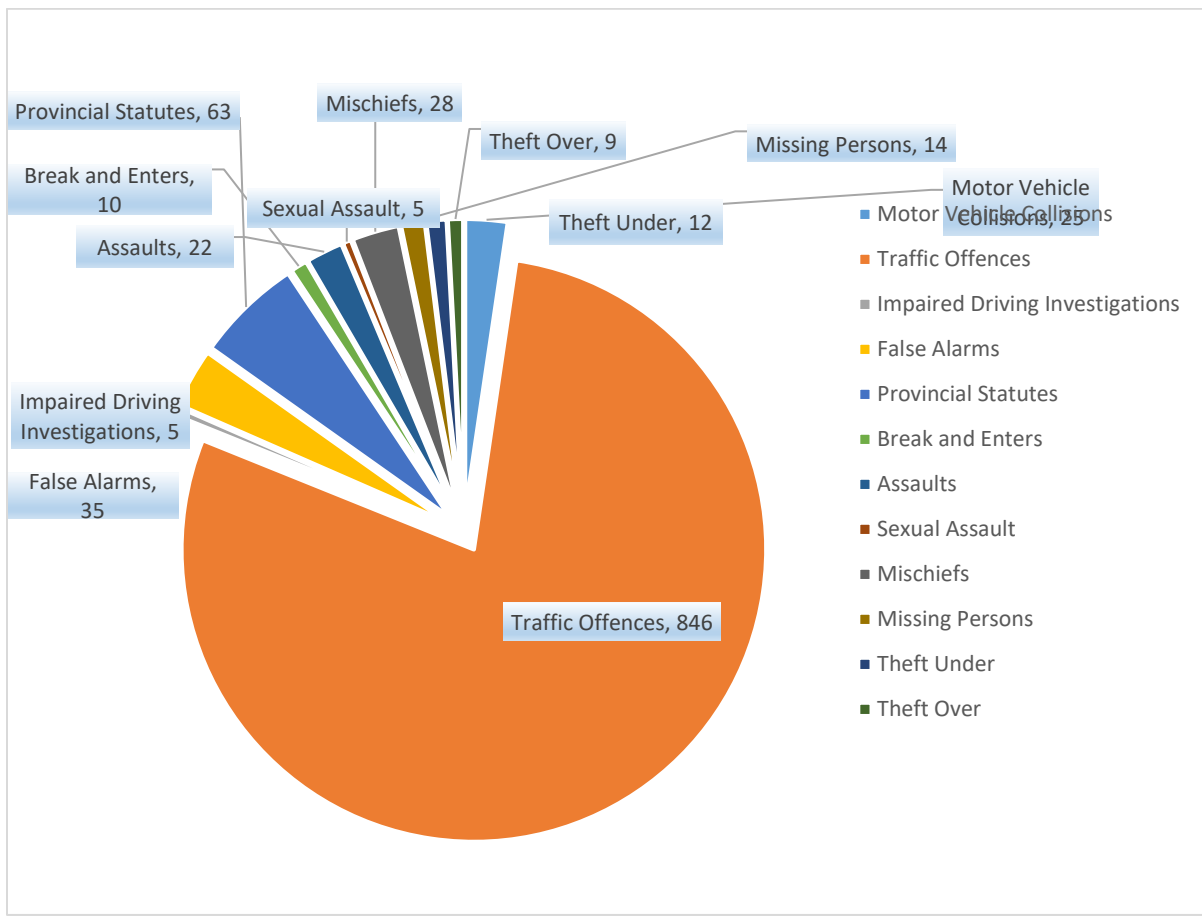
- S/Sgt. Detachment Commander, Sgt. Operations NCO and Cpl. Supervisor NCO positions are all filled at this time.
- One Detachment Services Assistant position is vacant and it is being filled by an employee from within the Public Service. White Butte welcomes Tamara Dale to the team!
- One Cst. position is vacant as the Team lost Cst. Peter Rhead in early July. Peter has been transferred to National Security in Regina. Staffing has been working to find a replacement.

#2. Calls for Service – Analysis last 42 days (August 10, 2023 to September 21, 2023)

- Total of 1471 occurrences generated.
- 25 traffic collisions - (21 reportable, 2 non-reportable, 1 injury, 1 fatal).

#3. Calls of Interest:

1 – On July 29th, White Butte Detachment was conducting patrols in the RM of Sherwood due to recent thefts and some rural break and enters. A particular property that had some thefts was patrolled to and a pickup truck could be seen there that should not be. A male was there hiding in the grass. The member started the investigation into what was going on. The male had a stolen vehicle and was trespassing. The male 49 year old Roland Roberge was charged with a section under the Trespass To Property Act and possession of property obtained by crime over 5000.00 under the Criminal Code. File 2023-1105498 refers.

2– On August 7th, White Butte received a call from a complainant stating they were just shot at by the occupant/s of a black Mercedes car while driving in White City and area. The black Mercedes was suspected to be a stolen vehicle. No persons were injured as a result of the occurrence. RCMP were going to put out an Everbridge alert on this black Mercedes car, however the vehicle showed up abandoned in the City of Regina soon after the incident. White Butte along with Regina Police Service spent many human resource hours to investigate. Once a suspect was identified and the investigation was complete a male from Regina has been arrested, remanded to the Provincial Correctional Centre and is facing numerous charges under the Criminal Code. File 2023-1155015 refers.

3- On September 2nd, White Butte members were dispatched to a rural area in the RM of South Qu'Appelle. The caller advised that a vehicle was just stolen from their farm. During this exchange the callers spouse was also assaulted. The victim sustained non-life threatening injuries. Members patrolled for the stolen vehicle. Members came into contact with the stolen vehicle and initiated a pursuit. Two people were arrested after the pursuit ended. 26 year old Joseph Antoine has been charged with aggravated assault, break and enter, dangerous operation of a motor vehicle, flight from peace officer, using firearm in the commission of an offence, pointing a firearm, possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose, possession of weapon contrary to order, theft of vehicle, other theft under 5000.00, operation while prohibited, careless use of a firearm, fail to comply, unauthorized possession of a firearm, break and enter and theft under 5000.00. 22 year old Taylor Asapace has been charged with break and enter, theft under \$5000.00, possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose, aggravated assault, another break and enter, theft of vehicle, theft under 5000.00, careless use of a firearm, unauthorized possession of a firearm and using a firearm in the commission of an offence. File 2023-1302174 refers.

4- On September 3rd, White Butte members were called to the party pits near Condie in the RM of Sherwood. Someone was bear macing the other party goers. The members attended the

scene and determined that all victims and accused persons were gone. On September 15th, White Butte members were called to the same party pits in the RM of Sherwood near Condie. A parent was picking their kids up from a party and she was bear sprayed. Members attended the scene and determined that the victim was no longer on scene. The suspect had fled the scene. The rest of the party goers dispersed from the scene. Any body left was warned to not come back there. File 2023-1311926 and 2023-1378313 refers.

#4. RPCC Investigations. 6 assaults, 2 assault causing bodily harm, 1 UAL, 2 CDSA, 1 indecent communications and 8 assistance files. The total for the reporting period is 20.
