## HIGHLIGHTS FROM JULY 9<sup>TH</sup> COUNCIL MEETING

- Council passed the Fire Prevention Bylaw 04-2019. This replaces the old Fire Restriction Bylaw. The Fire Prevention Bylaw addresses safe burning practices and much more.
- Council also passed the new Civic Addressing Bylaw 03-2019. This bylaw was created to help get the Town ready to become part of the provincial Civic Addressing Registry (CAR).
