2020 ASSESSMENT ROLL IS NOW OPEN

Notice was given on January 10, 2020 that the assessment roll for the Town of Grand Coulee for the year of 2020 has been prepared and open to inspection in the office of the assessor from 9:00am to 12:00pm and 12:30pm to 4:30pm on the following days: Monday to Friday, January 13, 2020 to February 14, 2020. A bylaw has been passed and the assessment notices have been sent as required.

Any person who wishes to appeal against his or her assessment is required to fill his or her notice of appeal, accompanied by an appeal fee of \$50.00 per \$100,000 of assessed value (up to a maximum fee of \$600) which will be returned if the appeal is successful, with: The Assessor, Town of Grand Coulee, Box 72, Site 200, Grand Coulee, SK S4P 2Z2, by the 14th day of February, 2020.
