TOWN OF GRAND COULEE BYLAW NO. 5-2025 A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A RECREATION COMMITTEE

WHEREAS pursuant to *The Municipalities Act*, a council may establish committees to assist in the efficient operation of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Grand Coulee recognizes the importance of recreational programs and services in enhancing community well-being and seeks to engage public participation in the development and promotion of recreation opportunities;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Grand Coulee, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

TITLE

This Bylaw may be cited as the "Recreation Committee Bylaw."

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Bylaw is to formally establish a Recreation Committee that will provide advice and recommendations to Council regarding recreational programs, services, and facilities in the Town of Grand Coulee.

ESTABLISHMENT

There is hereby established a committee of Council to be known as the Recreation Committee.

MANDATE

The Recreation Committee shall:

- a) Provide input and recommendations to Council on recreational services, programming, and capital improvements;
- b) Encourage public involvement in recreational activities;
- c) Assist with the promotion and organization of recreational events;
- d) Advise Council on long-term planning for recreational amenities and services;
- e) Follow all purchasing and procurement procedures in accordance with applicable legislation, municipal purchasing policies, and the Public Sector Accounting Board (PSAB) standards;
- f) Submit all recommendations, including budget requests and project proposals, to Council for review and formal approval;
- g) Ensure that all financial activities, transactions, revenues, and expenditures of the Committee are recorded and consolidated within the financial records of the Town;

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h) Ensure that all financial records of the Committee are subject to review as part of the Town's annual audit process and comply with all applicable financial reporting requirements.

COMPOSITION

- a) The Recreation Committee shall consist of at least four (4) members, appointed by resolution of Council, and shall include:
 - A minimum of one (1) members of Council; and
 - A minimum of two (2) members of the public who are residents or ratepayers of the Town of Grand Coulee.
- b) Additional members may be appointed by Council at its discretion.
- c) Members shall serve a term of two (2) years, unless otherwise determined by Council.
- d) The Committee shall elect a Chairperson and Secretary from among its members at its first meeting each calendar year.

MEETINGS AND PROCEDURES

- a) The Committee shall meet as needed or at the call of the Chairperson or Council, with a minimum of four (4) meetings annually.
- b) A quorum shall consist of a simple majority of the total appointed members.
- c) All meetings shall be conducted in accordance with Council's approved procedures and *The Municipalities Act*.
- d) Minutes of each meeting shall be recorded and submitted to the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) for inclusion in the Council agenda package.

LIMITATIONS

- a) The Recreation Committee is advisory in nature and shall have no decision-making authority.
- b) The Committee shall not expend funds, enter into contracts, or make binding commitments on behalf of the Town without the express written approval of Council.

COMPLIANCE

The Committee and its members shall:

- a) Adhere to all municipal bylaws, applicable provincial and federal legislation, including but not limited to *The Municipalities Act*, *The Local Authority Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (LAFOIP)*, and the applicable procurement and accounting standards (including PSAB);
- b) Abide by the Town's Code of Conduct and Conflict of Interest policies.

DISSOLUTION

Council may dissolve the Recreation Committee by resolution at any time if it is deemed no longer necessary or effective.

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EFFECTIVE DATE This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of its final passing by Council.
INTRODUCED AND READ a first time this 8 day of July, 2025. READ a second time this 8 day of July, 2025. UNANIMOUS AGREEMENT of full council that all three readings of this Bylaw will be done in one meeting this 8 day of July, 2025. READ a third time, adopted, signed and sealed on this 8 day of July, 2025.
