#1. White Butte Detachment Staffing Update:

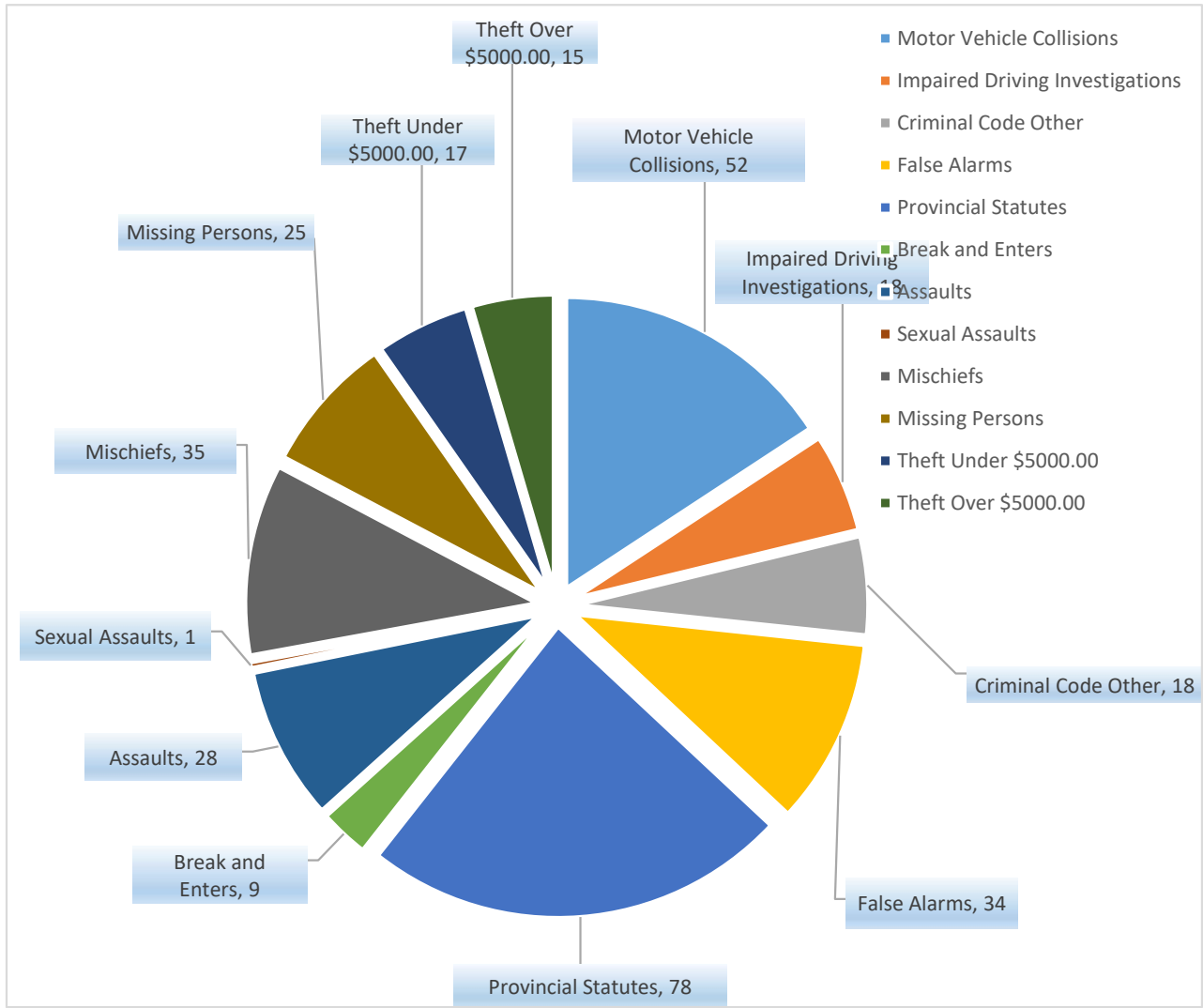
- S/Sgt. Detachment Commander position is filled at this time.
- Sgt. OPS NCO position is currently vacant as Sgt. Lee Knelsen has been transferred to Prince Albert. The new Sgt. has been named and a transfer has been issued for Sgt. Steven Ross from Estevan Detachment due to arrive in the fall.
- We are currently finalizing a competition for promotion to find a replacement for one of the Cpls. The process is in the final stages of selection, where the winning candidate will be named.
- Cpl. Derek Haines has arrived and started, he is getting settled into his new position.
- Cst. Nicole Peddigrew has arrived and started, she is getting settled into her new position.
- Cst. Andrew Zaichkowsky has been transferred to Newfoundland, His departure will be around September 2nd. Staffing has been looking to find a backfill replacement.

#3. Calls of Interest:

1 – On July 6th, White Butte members received a complaint from a fellow motorist that there was a suspicious vehicle on Courtney Street in the RM of Sherwood, west of Regina. The caller advised they were on their way towards the beach when they noticed a car parked with misc. items laying around outside of the vehicle. Members arrived to the scene and were met by a fully naked male that was extremely intoxicated / high. EMS attended the scene and transported the male to the hospital for medical assistance. The vehicle was towed away as it

was a road hazard. The 30 year old male was not charged with any offences from this incident. File 2024-951140 refers.

2 – On August 1st, White Butte received a complaint from the Shoppers Drug Mart in Emerald Park. A male and female came into the store. A few minutes later, two other males came in and distracted the sales associate by looking at other products. This distraction allowed the male and female time to steal Dior and YSL female fragrances in the amount of over \$9000.00. The suspects responsible are still outstanding for this occurrence. The investigation continues. File 2024-1104905 refers.

3 – On July 17th, White Butte received a call to the Town of Balgonie near the Flying J travel plaza. There was a single vehicle rollover. Members attended the scene to determine that the three occupants had fled the scene and two females were walking down the highway. There was suspected to be a male involved as well that was unaccounted for. Members contained the area and searched with police dog for the male. The females were arrested and a short while later the male was located by police hiding in the field. The vehicle that was rolled was stolen from the city of Regina. 24 year old Lakiesha Desjarlais, 22 Kimberlee Hastings and 30 year old Randy Netmaker have been charged with possession of property obtained by crime. Randy additionally has been charged with failure to stop after accident. File 2024-1011601 refers.

4- On August 1st, White Butte Detachment was called to an acreage north of Pilot Butte. The caller advised that someone has broken into the shop and their pickup truck is now missing, suspected to be stolen. Members attended to the scene and investigated the break enter and theft. Vehicle has not been recovered yet, it is a 2014 Chevrolet Silverado white in color. File 2024-1099865 refers.

5- On August 3rd and August 4th, White Butte Detachment received calls to the Sobey's Liquor Store in Emerald Park. A male had purchased a bottle of alcohol, exposed himself to the clerk and then walked out of the store. Members are completing parallel investigations and are applying for a search warrant to determine the identity of the male. The investigation continues. File 2024-1117318 refers.

6- On August 6th, White Butte Detachment was called to an acreage in the RM of Edenwold of a domestic dispute. Members attended to the scene and just before they arrived they came across a collision involving the male SOC and the female SOC's father. Members attended the scene and conducted their investigation. 39 year old female and the 40 year old male are being charged with assault on each other under the criminal code. File 2024-1133102 refers.

7- On August 11th, White Butte Detachment received a complaint of a truck that was stolen from a commercial property on the north side of Regina in the industrial area. Members are just beginning their investigation into the incident. File 2024-1157279 refers.
