

TOWN OF GRAND COULEE
BYLAW NO. 04-2026
A BYLAW TO DESIGNATE OUTDOOR PUBLIC SPACES FOR ALCOHOL
CONSUMPTION

WHEREAS the Government of Saskatchewan permits municipalities to designate outdoor public spaces for the consumption of beverage alcohol under the Alcohol and Gaming Regulations Act;

AND WHEREAS the Town of Grand Coulee wishes to allow responsible alcohol consumption in designated park areas;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Grand Coulee enacts as follows:

TITLE

This bylaw may be cited as the “*Open Liquor in Parks Bylaw.*”

DEFINITIONS

- “Designated Area” means any outdoor public space identified by signage as approved for alcohol consumption.
 - “Beverage Alcohol” refers to beer, wine, coolers, and similar products permitted under provincial law.
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DESIGNATION OF AREAS

The following parks are designated for alcohol consumption:

- The park containing the rink, shack, gazebo, athletic field and walking path
 - Alcohol may be consumed in posted areas during posted hours.
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CONDITIONS OF USE

- Only individuals of legal drinking age may consume alcohol.
 - Public intoxication is prohibited.
 - No glass containers are permitted.
 - Events with alcohol must comply with SLGA permit requirements.
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SIGNAGE AND USE

The Town shall post clear signage indicating:

- Permitted areas
 - Permitted hours
 - Rules of conduct
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ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement shall be carried out by local law enforcement.

EFFECTIVE DATES

This bylaw shall come into force September 18, 2026 at 12:01am and expire September 20, 2026 at 11:59pm.

INTRODUCED AND READ a first time this 9th day of June, 2026.

READ a second time this 9th day of June, 2026.

UNANIMOUS AGREEMENT of full council that all three readings of this Bylaw will be done in one meeting this 9th day of June, 2026.

READ a third time, adopted, signed and sealed on this 9th day of June, 2026.
