

# Council Remuneration Bylaw

## TOWN OF GRAND COULEE

### BYLAW NO 11-2023

#### A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE COUNCIL REMUNERATION

The Council of the Town of Grand Coulee in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The remuneration for members of council will be as follows:
  - a. \$120.00 per regular council meeting attended for councillors
  - b. \$180.00 per regular council meeting attended for mayor or alternate
  - c. \$20 per hour\* (including travel time) for 'required or expected to attend' meetings (ex. Special Council meetings, Committee meetings, walk-throughs), workshops, and conferences
    - \*Minimum \$20 and maximum of \$120 per meeting or event per day
  - d. Meals and mileage shall be at the same rate as the Provincial Public Service Commission.
2. Required or expected to attend meetings, workshops, and conferences shall be approved by a resolution (workshops, conventions, committees) or acknowledged (Special Council and other meetings) at a regular council meeting prior to meeting attendance. Exceptions to be approved at the discretion of Council.
3. Council members must keep a log of meals and mileage incurred.
4. There will be no income replacement if a councillor or mayor takes time off from his/her regular job to look after town business.
5. Payment of remuneration will be issued semi-annually (twice per year) no later than June 30<sup>th</sup> and December 31<sup>st</sup> each year.
6. Any member of council may decline any portion of their remuneration
7. Bylaw 02-2022 Council Remuneration Bylaw shall be repealed
8. This bylaw shall come into effective immediately on third reading.
