GENERAL POLICY:

The Town of Grand Coulee will provide the Grand Coulee Emergency Services personnel with protective clothing as recommended by the Fire Chief and by the First Responder's Manager. The Fire Chief and Manager will be responsible to assign this protective gear to active members. Individuals who are no longer active will have their gear reissued to new volunteers. The Grand Coulee Emergency Services will be eligible to receive a complementary jacket when they have provided two or more years of voluntary service to either the Grand Coulee Volunteer Fire Department or the Grand Coulee First Responder Unit. The Fire Chief and the Manager are each responsible to annually submit to Council a list of volunteers who qualify for complementary jackets. These jackets will have "Town of Grand Coulee Fire Department" or "Town of Grand Coulee First Responder" on the back and the volunteer's name on the front left chest area or sleeve. The Fire Chief and the Manager are each responsible to annually submit a list of volunteers who qualify for a 25 year service award. The details of this 25 year service award will be determined by the Council.
