Town of Grand Coulee Community Update

July 2026

I would like to take a moment to thank everyone who took the time to complete our community survey. Following a postponement due to scheduling conflicts, Council's Strategic Planning Session will take place during a closed Committee of the Whole meeting on July 7. Your survey responses are a key part of that planning process, and we truly appreciate everyone who participated. The survey results will be posted to the Town website shortly.

The issues with Portal notifications appear to have been resolved. Part of the problem was related to the SaskTel email address the notifications were being sent from. Going forward, Portal notifications will come from donotreply@grandcoulee.ca. As the address suggests, please do not reply to these emails. The inbox is not regularly monitored and exists solely for sending Portal notifications. As part of an initiative to help slow traffic along Railway Avenue, new stop signs are being installed at the intersections of Broadway and Centennial. In the spirit of cooperation, the Saskatchewan Ministry of Highways has agreed to install the signs at Centennial, as that section of Railway Avenue falls under its jurisdiction. Public Works will install the signs at Broadway as soon as conditions permit.

Just a reminder that this year's Hoedown is set for September 19. Council has once again passed a bylaw permitting open liquor in designated areas of the park during the event. If you're interested in helping with the planning or volunteering on the day of the Hoedown, please reach out to our new Program Manager, Adriana Brodner, at recreation@grandcoulee.ca. So far, only a couple of volunteers have stepped forward, and any extra hands would be greatly appreciated. As they say, many hands make light work!

By all accounts, our recent Kick Off to Summer event, organized by Adriana and funded through Sask Lotteries, was a great success. A sincere thank you to Adriana and to everyone who came out and helped make it such an enjoyable day for the community.

The Commissionaires have been out in the community assisting with bylaw enforcement. If you have a bylaw concern, please let the Town Office know and we will pass the information along. We're always happy to discuss any concerns you may have.

Repairs and remediation work on the Shack are underway and are expected to be completed by late July or early August. Repairs to the walking path are also in progress.
