#1. White Butte Detachment Staffing Update:


- -S/Sgt. Detachment Commander, Sgt. Operations NCO and Cpl. Supervisor NCO positions are all filled at this time.
- -One Cst. position is vacant. Staffing has updated us that a replacement has been found and should be transferred to White Butte Detachment this or next month.

#2. Calls for Service - Analysis last 28 days (September 22, 2023 to October 19, 2023)

#3. Calls of Interest:

- 1 On September 19th, White Butte Detachment was dispatched to Highway 46 between Balgonie and Pilot Butte (near Frankslake Road). There was a three vehicle collision which involved four people. One person (passenger) was pronounced deceased at the scene. Three others were injured and taken to hospital. Members attended the scene to conduct an investigation. The investigation still remains very active and may end up in criminal charges being laid. File 2023-1398390 refers.
- 2 On September 26th, White Butte Detachment opened an investigation due to information received that there was drugs being trafficked in/at the correctional facility at the Regina Provincial Correctional Centre. The investigation is open and active. So far there may be up to 16 inmates involved in the file as well as a Correctional Centre Guard that may or may not be involved in the trafficking. It is suspected that this will be a very complex and involved file due to the number of people involved and the culture surrounding these type of offences. File 2023-1434211 refers.
- 3 On October 2nd, White Butte members were on patrol to the West side of the Detachment area near the City of Regina heading out to Pense and Grand Coulee. The member spotted a truck, trailer and skid steer that seemed out of place with their hazard lights on. The member went in closer to investigate what was going on and there was no one around the truck, trailer and skid steer. The member confirmed that they were in fact stolen from City of Moose Jaw. A short while later three people attended the scene and were going to put gas in the truck from a jerry can they just brought with them. They were subsequently arrested for possession of property obtained by crime over \$5000.00. The investigation ended up with Arthur Stephen Pass (30) being charged with possession of property obtained by crime over \$5000.00 and fail to comply with undertaking and Nikita MacLeod (29) being charged with possession of property obtained by crime over \$5000.00. File 2023-1468760 refers.
- 4 On October 4th, White Butte Detachment received a "be on the look out" for a vehicle that was involved in a gas and dash in the Indian Head Detachment area. White Butte members were watching for the vehicle to show up near Regina and sure enough, it did! After a spike belt attempt members were able to perform a high risk arrest of the two vehicle occupants. 32 year old Donavan Jarvis was charged with possession of property obtained by crime over \$5000.00, operation while prohibited, dangerous operation of a motor vehicle, flight and failing to comply with release order and undertaking. 22 year old Destiny Osborne was charged with possession of property obtained by crime over \$5000.00. File 2023-1479040 refers.

- 5 On October 7th, White Butte Detachment was dispatched to Highway 48 near the Town of Davin. There was a two vehicle collision which involved three persons. Both vehicle drivers and one dog was pronounced deceased at the scene. Members attended the scene to investigate the collision. It does not seem, so far, that any criminal charges will be stemming from this occurrence. File 2023-1466197 refers.
- 6 On October 9th, White Butte Detachment was dispatched to a single vehicle collision on the Regina Bypass (West side of Regina at the Armour Road intersection) where the vehicle was now abandoned. Members attended and started an investigation which actually lead to an impaired investigation. Members worked diligently and found the registered owner / accused at home. Subsequently 54 year old Steven Jorven was charged with impaired driving and driving while over 80 mg% under the Criminal Code. 2023-1506472 refers.
- **#4. RPCC Investigations.** 2 assaults, 3 CDSA, 1 possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose, 1 fail to comply with order and 27assistance files. The total for the reporting period is 34.
