▶ CLOSED PERMITS - SHAREPOINT

If you haven't already, you will soon be receiving a link from our office granting you access to our PBI SharePoint site, where copies of your completed permits are stored. You may choose to leave the files on the site or download them for your records. This folder will be updated monthly, following the release of our Completed Permits Reports.

▶ COMMERCIAL INTAKE REVIEWS

Owners may now request a preliminary intake review for their commercial projects at no cost. This is a high-level (non-exhaustive) review intended to identify key requirements early and help reduce delays during the plan review stage. HENRY'S LAW

Introduced May 5, 2026 by the Minister of Government Relations

Named in memory of Henry Losco (who passed away from carbon monoxide poisoning), the Province's amendment requires carbon monoxide (CO) alarms in all multi-unit residential buildings by November 1, 2026, regardless of when the building was initially built.
