- Need to do some fall cleanup? We will have two large bins in town at the Fire Hall on Saturday, September 14th from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Please ensure that all refuse is put inside the bins, anything left outside of the bins will NOT be collected. These bins are to be used by Grand Coulee residents only.
- Now that the kids are back in school, we want to remind motorists when approaching a school bus, if you see amber flashing lights, slow down and proceed with caution. If the red flashing lights are activated, you must come to a complete stop. If you are approaching the bus from the opposite direction on an undivided highway, you must also stop. Passing a school bus with red flashing lights is a serious offence and will result in a minimum fine of \$360.
