- Council approved the 2021 Budget. There will be no change to the mill rate and base tax is \$732 for land and \$349 for improvements. 2021 Property Tax Notices will be sent out by email or mail in March. Taxes are due in full by September 30th.

2021 Assessment Roll is now Open

Notice was given on January 21, 2021 that the assessment roll for the Town of Grand Coulee for the year of 2021 has been prepared and is open to inspection in the office of the assessor from 8:30am to 12:00pm and 12:30pm to 4:30pm on the following days: Monday to Friday, January 25, 2021 to March 26, 2021. A bylaw pursuant to section 214 of The Municipalities Act has been passed and the assessment notices have been sent as required.

Any person who wishes to appeal against his or her assessment is required to file his or her notice of appeal, accompanied by an appeal fee of \$50.00 per \$100,000 of assessed value (up to a maximum fee of \$600) which will be returned if the appeal is successful, with: The Assessor, Town of

School Bus Etiquette

It appears some drivers are not aware of basic school bus and school zone safety. We want to remind motorists when approaching a school bus, if you see amber flashing lights, slow down and proceed with caution.

If the red flashing lights are activated, you must come to a complete stop. If you are approaching the bus from the opposite direction on an undivided highway, you must also stop. Passing a school bus with red flashing lights is a serious offence and will result in a minimum fine of \$360.

The single greatest threat to the safety of children who ride school buses is motorists who pass the bus when children are loading or unloading. For more info visit: <https://www.sgi.sk.ca/>
