- Council reviewed the draft Strategic Plan. Thanks to your input during the survey, Council has been able to develop priorities and direction to help guide the Town for the next 3 to 5 years. Once approved, the Strategic Plan and supporting documents will be available on our website.
- Amendments to the Nuisance Bylaw were given first reading. The amendments clarify the definition of junked vehicle. A public hearing will be held on August 17, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. at the Town Hall for anyone who wishes to ask questions or provide feedback on the changes.
- Council passed a resolution to change the start time of all regular council meetings from 7:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.

Effective July 20, 2021, due to the much needed rain fall and reduce fire risk, the Town's fire ban has been lifted.

The 2021 road work season continues. Thank you to everyone for respecting the roads.

To date Corbin Bay, Brayden Bay, Rider Bay, Harvest Bay, Samantha Street, Fairfax Street, Blair Street, Wilfred Street, Park Street, English Bay, Broadway Street, and a portion of Assiniboia have been completed.

Please ensure vehicles are moved off the street during this time and try to avoid driving on them immediately following the oil application. Traffic may experience minor delays during the roadwork as we reduce some roads to one lane only and/or restrict traffic to local traffic only (no thru traffic) where applicable. Please use alternate routes through Town if at all possible.

Motorists are advised to obey all signs and to exercise extreme caution when travelling through the site and near crews and equipment.

Hall Rental

Did you know the hall is open for rent? Enjoy the comfort of air conditioning during all of your summer events. Your rental includes the use of tables/chairs and kitchen. Renters are responsible for restoring the facility to the way it was when you came in and the removal of garbage.

Rental fees are as follows:

- Damage Deposit (refundable) - \$100
- Rental Fee ½ day - \$40.00 up to three hours
- Rental Fee Full day - \$80.00 anything over three hours in one day

If the event is a fundraiser for the community or another not-for-profit community service, there is no fee for the facility.
